	£30k, I know of another that has £60k and another of £100k. And yet
	these parish councils continue to increase their precept, for example,
	Corringham planned increase is 16.6% for next year. WLDC cannot
	take control of these reserves, but it can expose the 'scandal' of
	parish councils holding considerable reserves that are not identified
	for costed up projects during this cost-of-living crisis, when
	households are struggling to meet demands. 16.6% increase on band
	F is already causing concern amongst householders. One idea is for
	Parish Councils not to set a precept and reduce their reserves over a
	period of time. Not all parish councils have substantial reserves and
	an audit of those that have may be interesting. We require greater
	accountability in our parish councils and training to support those
	responsible for budget planning and precept setting.
